



Robertson Collection

This image is one of many lithograph prints in the Robertson collection. This collection comprises over three thousand prints and various ephemera related to the Greek War of Independance (1821 - 1829). A primary goal was to systematically document each object for preservation and record-keeping purposes. For maximum detail in resolution, each photograph is composited. A practical demonstration of reproduction was made using this image and printing it on archival cotton-rag paper at twice the original size.



奈良県聖林寺十一面観音立像は、日本で最初に国宝に指定された仏像の一つである。およそ1300年前天平時代に造られた。本像は木心乾漆造という木や漆などの植物系の材料を用いる技法で造られている。その技法は7-8世紀東亜で隆盛したが、現在日本にしか残ってない。本研究は最新の科学調査(3Dスキャンニング)により得られた情報に基づき、造像当初の構造技法と材料を用い模刻制作を行うことで、本像が造られた当時の姿勢改変などを解明した。







Plan of Osaka Castle



One of two covers created for my master's thesis. During the COVID19 pandemic, in-person submission was discouraged and students were required to submit PDF versions. My research pertained to a certain type of local ceramic which features the use of two glazes. Under certain conditions they create blue trails. As such, I wanted to feature a macro image of this surface-glaze phenomena to match the title *Landscapes of Black, Blue, and White.* Using a macro lens with an extension tube, I was able to capture the perfect image for this.



HACHIYOZA

The Hachiyoza is an historic Kabuki theatre located in Yamaga and founded in 1910. This theatre was established by the local merchants of the area for entertainment. It should be noted that the theatre is multipurposed, and other forms of entertainment are performed here aside from Kabuki. The crest of the theatre is an ingenious work of design, playing on the name of the theatre: eight kanji for sen 千 surround the katakana for yo 3.










Due to the frequent stopping and many hours of walking required, a light camera with a wide-angle lens provided the most practical choice for documenting the journey. Although each year's trip differs in location and theme, this report was chosen in order to highlight the program's activities for this special course.














Knedlhans Catalogue

Adobe Lightroom, Photoshop, Indesign, Illustrator. A print-on-demand catalogue completed in 2018 for a local collector of Korean ceramics. Three objectives were completed: to provide further insight, to construct a record for preservation, and to allow the collector to share her works. Photography was completed on-site in their studio using a three-point lighting setup with the primary fill coming from an overhead softbox. In post-production, I researched each object using a comparative analysis in order to identify, date, and provide context. High-resolution images of the surfaces were especially helpful in certain cases and these detail shots have been included.



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
